

## Principles

- We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all the pupils.
- We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed.
- In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils. We recognise that not all pupils who receive free school meals will be socially disadvantaged.
- We also recognise that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals. We reserve the right to allocate the Pupil Premium funding to support any pupil or groups of pupils the school has legitimately identified as being socially disadvantaged.
- Pupil premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups or individuals. Limited funding and resources means that not all children receiving free school meals will be in receipt of pupil premium interventions at one time.

## Provision

The range of provision the Governors may consider making for this group could include:

- Teaching Assistant Support.
- 1 to 1 tuition with teaching staff.
- Small group intervention with teaching staff.
- Nurture Mathematic group for targeted pupils.
- Provide able children with the support needed to achieve the higher levels of achievement.

of the Head teacher, or a delegated member of staff, to produce regular reports for the Governors curriculum subcommittee on:

- The progress made towards narrowing the gap, by year group, for socially disadvantaged pupils
- An outline of the provision that was made since the last meeting.

The Governor who has the responsibility for overseeing Pupil Premium (Mrs D Ulliott) will report to the Full Governing Body.

The Governors of the school will ensure that there is an annual statement to parents on how the Pupil Premium funding has been used to address the issue of narrowing the gap for socially disadvantaged pupils. This task will be carried out within the requirements published by the Department for Education. A summary of analysis for the previous year will be posted on the school website.

Any appeals against this policy will be through the governors' complaints procedure.
